DAY 1: AMMAN AIRPORT – AMMAN HOTEL

Our representative welcomes you with a signage at Amman Airport. Transfer about 45 minutes to Amman hotel, rest of the day is free, check in & overnight.

DAY 2: AMMAN HOTEL - UMM QUIAS - JERASH - AJLOUN - AMMAN HOTEL (B)

We drive two hours to Umm Qais, which belonged to the famous Decapolis, a union of 10 cities, founded by Alexander the Great. Afterwards to Jerash, the best example of a Roman provincial city in the whole Middle East. Next stop is Ajloun the great 12th century Islamic castle built around 1184/85 by the famous Islamic leader Salah al-Din. Transfer to Amman.

DAY 3: HOTEL - AMMAN CITY TOUR - DESERT CASTLES - AMMAN HOTEL (B)

Start our tour to the Desert Castles we visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site Amra with its zodiac dome and Omayyad fresco paintings. Moreover you view the fortress-like mysterious Qasr Kharanah and the black basalt Roman/Medieval Islamic fort at Azraq. In Amman we visit Citadel hill with remains from the Roman to the early Islamic period and the Roman Theatre. We stroll via the Souq and Jabal Amman with its distinctive early 20th century architecture. Overnight Amman.

DAY 4: AMMAN HOTEL – MADABA – MT. NEBO – KING'S WAY - KERAK – PETRA HOTEL (B)

Drive to Madaba, where to find the famous mosaic 6th century map of Palestine in St. George's church. After we proceed to Mt. Nebo, the place where Prophet Moses gazed at the Promised Land before he died. Driving along the famous ancient caravan route the King's Way, we have a short stop in Wadi Al-Mujib, a great wide valley with magnificent geological formation. In Kerak visit the famous Crusader castle built in 1132/34 by King Baldwin I of Jerusalem. Overnight Petra.

DAY 5: PETRA VISIT – WADI RUM CAMP (B, D)

After breakfast visit Petra, one of the New Seven Wonders of the world, and since 1985 a UNESCO World Heritage Site. With the guide pass the canyon, the so called Siq, to see the most beautiful monument: the Treasury. Continue via the Street of Facades to the Royal Tombs and Pharaoh's Castle. The guide says farewell to you at the restaurant area, free time on your own, in the afternoon we drive 1.5 hrs to Wadi Rum, dinner and overnight at camp.

DAY 6: RUM JEEP TOUR – DEAD SEA BEACH – AMMAN HOTEL (B)

Breakfast at camp. By 4x4 Jeep tour you discover canyons, sand dunes and Nabatean rock inscriptions. Proceed to the lowest point on earth, the Dead Sea here you have leisure time to float on salty waters. Transfer to Amman for overnight.

DAY 7: AMMAN HOTEL - AMMAN AIRPORT (B)

Breakfast at hotel, depending to your departure time transfer to Amman airport to board your flight.
